Meet our wonderful art teacher Mrs. Kraus. Steins students enjoy art class each and every day.

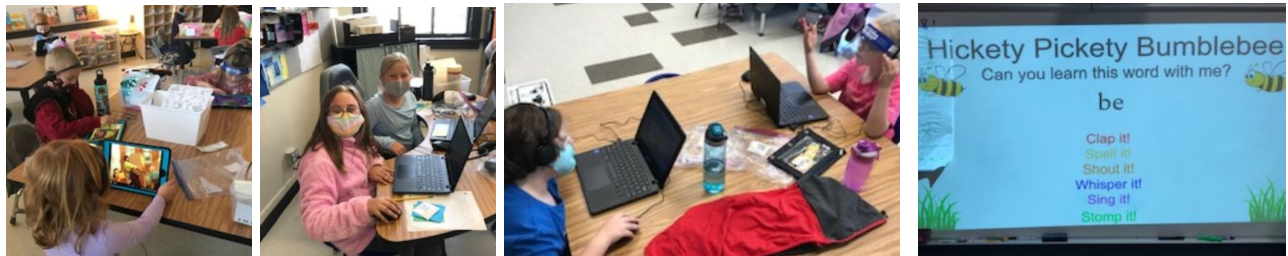
