We learned this week that the Safe Harbor designation has been extended! That means Crook County School District will reopen for all K-12 students on Monday, January 4th.


We ask that students please bring back all materials that were sent home in December. This includes your iPad or Chrome, chargers, computer cases, and any other materials for class.
