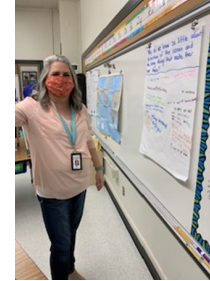

Staff Spotlight



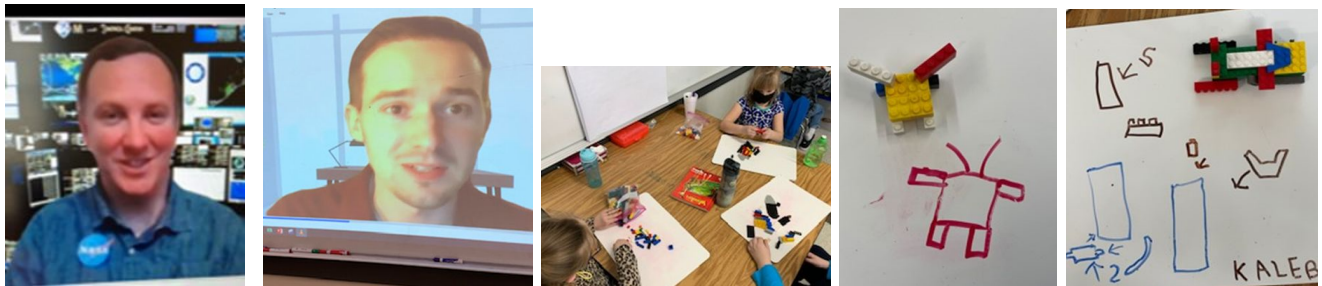
